*You are welcome to work in either Oil or acrylic paints in this class; however, some of the techniques I teach are much better suited for oil paints rather than acrylics. If you work in and own both, I encourage you to bring oil paints to this class. The paints list below describes the tubes for oil painting; however, if you choose to work in acrylic, please purchase the colours listed below in Acrylic paint.

- Drawing Paper
- Pencils- 2B, HB
- Kneaded Eraser
- Pencil Sharpener
- Palette- (avoid **white** disposable palettes. A good disposable brand is called 'Grey Matters')
- Palette knife for mixing
- Linseed Oil (For oil painters)
- Retarder (For Acrylic painters)
- Gamblin Odorless Mineral Spirits (For oil painters) (make sure you bring this specific brand)
- Paper Towels
- Small Plastic cup or Container
- Brush Cleaning soap (A good one is a bar of Laundry soap called 'Linda', available at most dollar stores!)
- Gray Scale and Value Finder 4" x 6"

Canvas

1 Canvas- 11" x 14" or larger

1 Pad of canvas paper- 8.5 x 11" or larger (Strathmore Canvas Paper Pads is a good brand)

Oil Paints: 37 ml tubes are fine. Please try to bring a good student or professional brand. A more economical brand is 'Winton' while a higher quality brand is 'Windsor Newton Artists' Oil Colour'. Other good brands are Gamblin and Williamsburg.
