



Adult Material List

Welcome to the Avenue Road Arts School's *Intermediate Acrylic Painting* with Martha Johnson

Please bring the following materials to the first class.

PAINTS

(Acrylic Only: Try not to buy student grade paints. I would rather you purchased small tubes of quality artist's paint such as Golden, Liquitex or Stevenson)

Raw Umber	Yellow Ochre/Yellow Oxide	Cadmium Red (middle – no hues)
Chromium oxide green	Cerulean blue	
Alizarin Crimson	Red Oxide	Cadmium Yellow (middle – no hues)
Ultramarine blue	Hansa Yellow	

White Gesso (no smaller than 8oz)-gesso will be used as a mixing white

Acrylic Matte Medium (no smaller than 8oz.)

You must purchase a few pigments that excite you beyond the essential palette

BRUSHES

Brush range in size from #2 to #24

It is not necessary to have more than 5 brushes for the first class. I recommend having more large and medium sized brushes than small sized ones. Also, please have two 1” ‘bright’ brushes. Please bring both natural bristle brushes and acrylic bristle brushes for acrylic paint.

For beginners, you should have at least one fine brush for details. Ultimately, you should have a total of 5 to 9 brushes. (ABSOLUTELY NO FAN BRUSHES, PLEASE) + 1 ‘rigger’ brush for detail. This is a small ‘lettering’ brush with soft bristles about 1” long which is a very small round ‘lettering’ brush with bristles about 1” long.

PAINTING SURFACES

Bring a canvas no smaller than 12”x14” . Bring a large canvas pad (can be canvas or acrylic paper) approximately 18"x24" . Canvas pad contains 10-15 sheets suitable for class exercises.

MISCELLANEOUS

Water container (large yoghurt containers)

Large Disposable Palette pad or wax paper over board -essential

Brush soap

Willow sticks - medium

1 Pad of Newsprint

Long Ruler

Masking Tape

J-Cloths or any other rags to wipe brushes

Scissors
