Welcome to the Avenue Road Arts School's Painting for Beginners with Martha Johnson

Please bring the following materials to the first class.

PAINTS (Acrylic Only)

Try not to buy student grade paints. I would rather you purchased small tubes of quality artist's paint such as Stevenson, Liquitex or Golden.

Yellow Ochre/Yellow Oxide	Raw Umber Chromium Oxide Green	Hansa Yellow Cadmium Red (middle – no hues)
Cadmium Yellow (middle – no hues)	Alizarin Crimson Ultramarine Blue	
Cerulean Blue	Red Oxide	

Acrylic Matte Medium (no smaller than 8oz.)
White Gesso (no smaller than 8oz.) - gesso will be used as a mixing white.

BRUSHES

Brush range in size from #2 to #24

It is not necessary to have more than 5 brushes for the first class. I recommend having more large and medium sized brushes than small sized ones. Also, please have two 1" 'bright' brushes. Please bring acrylic bristle brushes for acrylic paint. Ultimately, you should have a total of 9 brushes. (ABSOLUTELY NO FAN BRUSHES, PLEASE) + 1 'riggor' brush for detail. A riggor is a small round lettering brush with soft bristles about 1" long.

PAINTING SURFACES

Bring a canvas no smaller than 12"x14". Bring a large canvas pad (can be canvas or acrylic paper) approximately 18"x24". Canvas pad contains 10-15 sheets suitable for class exercises.

MISCELLANEOUS

Water container (large yoghurt containers)
Disposable Palette pad-large
Brush soap
Willow sticks-small or fine
1 Pad of Newsprint
Long Ruler
Masking Tape
J-cloths or any other rags to wipe brushes
Scissors
